## **Reporting Priorities by Percentage**

There are 33 Regulatory Initiatives listed under the four Regulatory Priorities in the IPC Regulatory Plan 2020-22. This quarter, 1 initiative was finalised as follows:

- Regulatory Priority 1:
  - S2I2. Assess utilisation of the Information Governance Agency Selfassessment Tools to support review by I&R and LCRA
- Regulatory Priority 2:
  - There were no regulatory initiatives finalised for the quarter.
- Regulatory Priority 3:
  - There were no regulatory initiatives finalised for the quarter.
- Regulatory Priority 4:
  - There were no regulatory initiatives finalised for the quarter.

In this quarter (Q1 2020/21) of reporting, the IPC finalised 1 (3.0%) of the 33 Regulatory Initiatives.

The IPC's Regulatory Plan commenced in January 2020 and between January and June a total of 11 (33.3%) Regulatory Initiatives were finalised. Accordingly, there was an increase of finalised initiatives of 1 (3.0%) this quarter, with a total of 12 (36.3%) of all Regulatory Initiatives being finalised on 1 October 2020.
