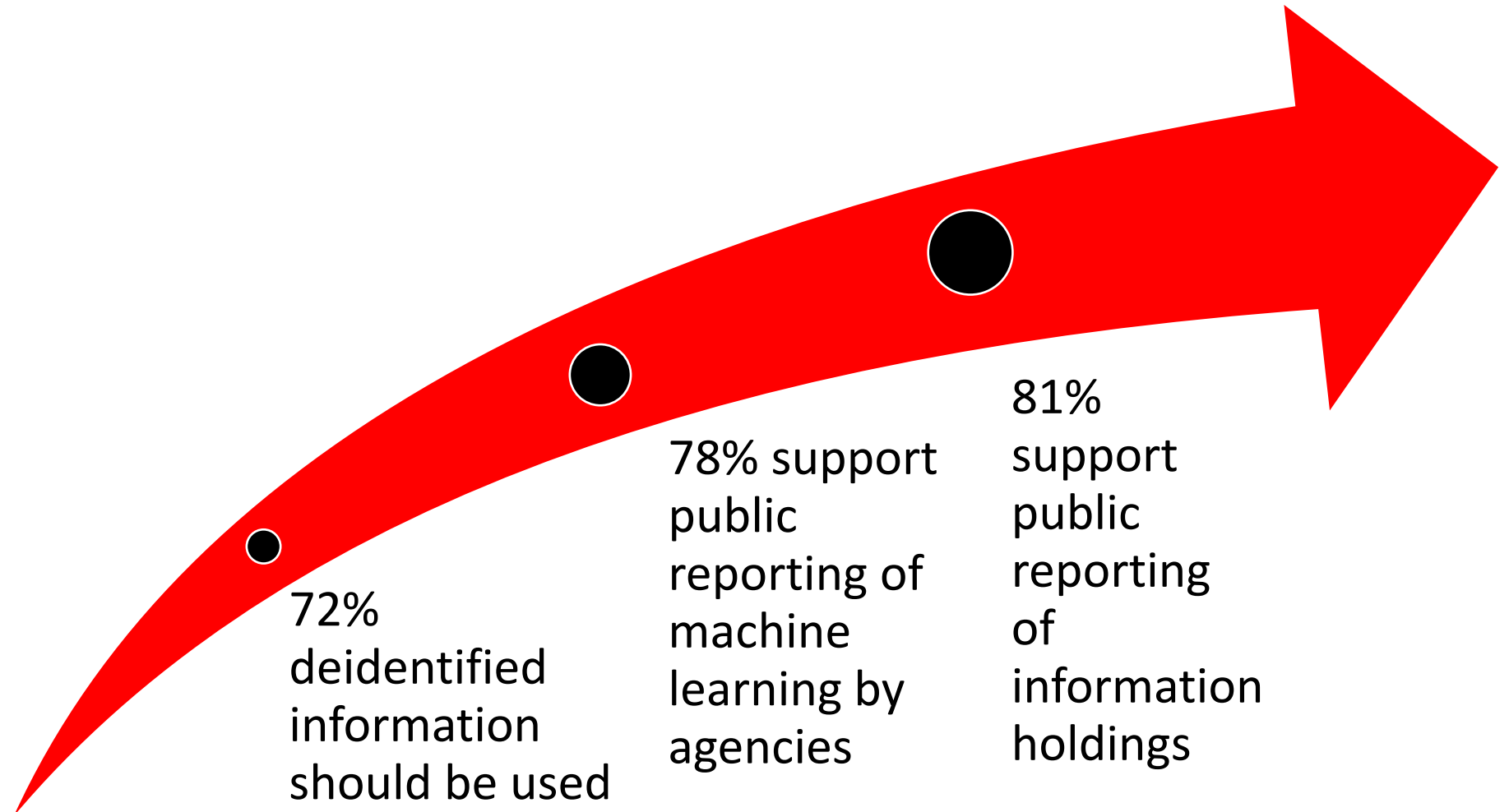


The 2021 government information landscape
